

Minutes of Meeting Dated 26th October 2023

- 1. It was emphasized that the Alumni Interaction series should be conducted on a regular basis to foster stronger connections between the alumni and our institution.
- 2. A request was made to provide the contact details (including phone numbers and personal email addresses) of the top 10 alumni who have not already been approached for video interviews.
- 3. The importance of maintaining an updated Alumni Committee report throughout the year was emphasized. It was advised to consistently update and maintain the necessary data.
- 4. The need to collect and retain appointment letters of all alumni was highlighted. Efforts should be made to gather any missing appointment letters.
- 5. It was decided that registering on Alma connect should be made compulsory for all graduating batches. This will help in maintaining a comprehensive alumni database and facilitate effective communication.
- 6. We discussed the importance of reaching out to alumni who are not actively connected on Alma connect and other social media platforms. It was suggested to utilize social media channels to engage with them. The student Alumni subcommittee should be assigned the task of contacting old alumni and collecting their updated details. The students can also pull their details from their convocation forms.
- 7. The names of the student sub-committee members should be sent to me for record-keeping and coordination purposes.

The schools who have not formed student Sub-committee, kindly form it at the earliest.

- 8. It was requested to provide the names of students who are responsible for capturing events using the specified format.
- 9. The idea of involving alumni in the curriculum designing process was discussed. Efforts should be made to engage alumni in this area.








- 10. To enhance admissions, it was suggested to actively engage in social media by promoting all school events and alumni-related activities.
- 11. The importance of hosting an annual alumni meet was stressed upon, and it was decided that such a meet should be organized compulsorily every year.
- 12. The mentor-mentee program should be promoted through Alma connect. For those alumni who are not on Alma connect, manual coordination can be done.
- 13. It was proposed to conduct free workshops exclusively for alumni to provide them with valuable learning opportunities.
- 14. The Alumni Committee Reports should be signed and sent in hard copy to me. For those who have already submitted the reports to Dr. Sharad, I will collect them directly from him.
- 15. It was advised to begin sending requests to alumni through Alma connect and social media.
- 16. Alumni card soft copy soon to be introduced. Soft copy to be signed by HOD of respective school & Head of Alumni relations. Demo to get soft copy will be given to all. Verification of alumni has to be done by coordinator & team.
- 17. Any updates made on Alma Connect should be clearly and effectively communicated to ensure that the information is well-articulated.
- 18.If you require any updates regarding the alumni section on the website, kindly submit a one-page document including content and pictures in the format previously (communicated) to Prashant. Please ensure to copy me and Vrundan sir for coordination purposes.






